

Gratal and Gabardiella were two mountains who were united and in love, which is how lovers tend to be.


But Gabardiella's father did not approve of the relationship. His daughter was young and beautiful and Gratal was already an old hill and would surely die soon.

SAN MARTÍN OF THE VAL D ONSERA

This is the location of the Geocache: N 42° 14.382 W 000° 17.259

Hint: About 2/3 of the way along the channel you will find an open space (like a cave but with high ceilings) on both sides. At shoulder height (in the "roof"), behind stones, you will find it. TAKE CARE! It is a difficult route, and it is well maintained and is very safe, but you need to go properly equipped for trekking.



This is the location of the Geocache: N 42° 17.473 W 000° 04.760 Hint: From the cache we can see part of a wall. Placed by: Buenaventuraalquezar



THE GORGES DE SAN JULIAN

N 42° 16.518 W 000° 27.727 By the door of the hermitage, get under the fig tree, but look at the wall.



THE EGG OF DAN COSME AND SAN DAMIÁN

42°15'04.0"N 0°16'08.7" W Look for a sign with a squirrel. Carry GPS because there is no mobile phone signal. Placed by: Clandestine Pre-Pyrenees
